Colombia's legal abortion context

Decriminalization of abortion

Profamilia is permanently working to guarantee access to abortion services as one of its main objectives, supporting, among other, legislative advances such as:

2006

Abortion was partially decriminalized on three grounds:

- I. When there is a risk to the life or health of the woman or pregnant person, certified by a doctor.
- II. When there is an incompatibility of fetal life outside the uterus, certified by a doctor.
- III. When the pregnancy is the result of sexual violence.

2022

The Constitutional Court took a historic step, decriminalizing abortion up to 24 weeks of pregnancy.

Profamilia provided technical concepts and massively summoned national and international actors to present public interventions providing arguments to the magistrates that helped them achieved the decision.

When a person exceeds 24 weeks of pregnancy they can access voluntary abortion under the three grounds outlined in the 2006 law.



Following decriminalization of abortion (2022 – 2024)

The number of services provided by Profamilia increased by 118% compared to the three years prior to Ruling C-055 of 2022.

Over **149,000 women and people with the capacity to become pregnant** accessed safe abortion services in the past three years.

Program for the Prevention and Care of Unintended Pregnancy (PAEND) for international patients

Profamilia stands out in Colombia for providing safe, timely, and confidential care to women and other pregnant-capable individuals with the capacity to gestate who wish to terminate their pregnancy. Today, offers a dedicated care pathway for international patients traveling from abroad. As part of essential healthcare, access to abortion services is guaranteed at all gestational ages, along with contraceptive methods and personalized counseling, all within a professional, comprehensive, and judgment-free environment.

6,940 foreign national users have been served since the decriminalization of abortion in 2022 through 2024, coming from countries such as Venezuela, Ecuador, France, Mexico, and others.



The care pathway for international patients includes virtual counseling prior to arrival, information on travel requirements, and continuous support during their stay in Colombia.



Mia

It is a legal and safe telemedicine service for abortion with medication up to the 12th week of pregnancy, from your home or a trusted space, with information, counseling, and support from Profamilia's health professionals.

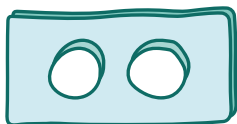

Mifepristone

In 2016, **Profamilia** succeeded in including Mifepristone as a medication for abortion in Colombia. In December 2024, it obtained an update to the guidelines for its use, in accordance with ruling C-055 of 2022, the WHO guidelines, and the Ministry of Health, expanding its use beyond 63 days of gestation.





Global Care

The Global consortium for Abortion and Reproductive Self-care.

This global consortium, led by Profamilia, aims to improve abortion self-care practices in eleven countries by developing, implementing, and sharing knowledge of person-centered care models that respond to different contexts and engage the community and institutional actors to ensure timely and high-quality access to information and services.
